- Continue to study hard and follow your four-year plan.
- Sign up to take the [PLAN](#) test (Preliminary ACT) during the fall to prepare you for the ACT, a college entrance exam. The PLAN also includes a career interest inventory.
- Meet with your guidance counselor to talk about your college and career plans, and how you are progressing towards your goals and high school [graduation requirements](#).
- Continue to add to your resume as you participate in [extracurricular](#) activities in school or the community.
- If you haven't already, begin some type of [community service](#).
- Take advantage of every opportunity to participate in enrichment activities, including [summer programs](#) (Passport Scholarships for girls, Governor's School, etc.).
- Visit the guidance department and explore college catalogs and other materials.
