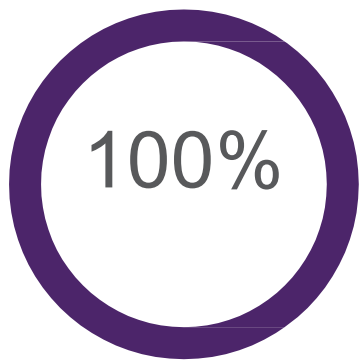

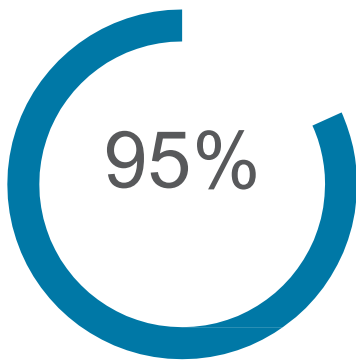
The Camp College experience involves

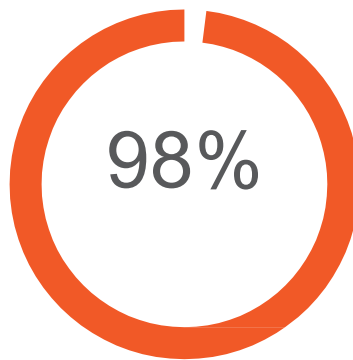

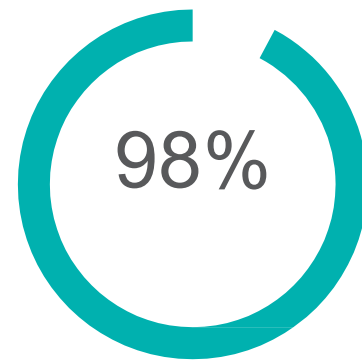
application rate among participants to college
